

## **Time Line: Napoleon's Rise to Power**

<b>July 27, 1794</b>	<b>Fall of Robespierre</b>
<b>Aug. 22, 1795</b>	<b>National Convent. proclaims new Const.</b>
<b>Oct. 5, 1795</b>	<b>Napoleon breaks up royalist protest of new Constitution</b>
<b>Oct. 26, 1795</b>	<b>Convention dissolved -&gt; Directory</b>
<b>Mar. 5, 1796</b>	<b>war against the HRE</b>
<b>July 8, 1797</b>	<b>Cisilpine Rep. proclaimed in Northern Italy</b>
<b>Sep. 4, 1797</b>	<b>Coup d' Fructidore (p. 386) Directory annuls 1797 elections Republicans over royalists Desire to spread rev. ideals</b>
<b>Oct. 17, 1797</b>	<b>Treaty of Campo Formio (Austria) Recog French annex of Belgium, French control of left bank of Rhine, and French dominated Cisilpine Rep.</b>
<b>Feb. 1798</b>	<b>Roman Republic proclaimed</b>
<b>Apr. 1798</b>	<b>Helvetic Republic proclaimed (Switz) marks end of HRE based on German princes' land grab</b>
<b>7 / 1798 – 8 / 1799</b>	<b>Napoleon in Egypt / instigating war against Britain</b>
<b>Nov. 9, 1799</b>	<b>Coup d' Brumaire (p. 387) End of Directory -&gt; Consulate Napoleon as First Consul (1802: Nap as 1<sup>st</sup> Consul... for life!)</b>
